The Importance of Donation Receipts

Being able to issue official Donation Tax Receipts is one of the most important benefits of being a Registered Charity.

It is rarely the driving reason people give but **40.7% of people agree that the ability to receive a tax credit increases their likelihood to give.** Younger generations are more likely to agree with this statement.


Does the ability to receive a tax credit for your charitable gifts increase your likelihood to give?

The Importance of Donation Receipts

- Of those that don't donate, 35.4% have said that the main reason why is because "I can't afford to give to charity".
- A donor can receive as much as 53% back through charitable tax deductions depending on their province and the amount they donate.





Issuing Official Donation Receipts

According to the CRA, 89% of charities are not issuing them correctly.

Some of the most common issues are:

- issuing a receipt with inaccurate or missing information;
- issuing a receipt for a transaction that does not qualify as a gift;
- issuing a receipt on behalf of another organization; or
- issuing a receipt for an inflated amount


If you are unsure about issuing a receipt, the best call is to not issue one.



What is Required on Official Donation Receipts?

Official donation receipts must include:

- a statement that it is an official receipt for income tax purposes
- the name and address of the charity as on file with the Canada Revenue Agency (CRA)
- a unique serial number
- the registration number issued by the CRA
- the location where the receipt was issued (city, town, municipality)
- the date or year the gift was received
- the date the receipt was issued
- the full name, including middle initial, and address of the donor
- the amount of the gift
- the amount and description of any advantage received by the donor
- the eligible amount of the gift
- the signature of an individual authorized by the charity to acknowledge gifts
- the name and website address of the CRA



In addition to these requirements, charities are legally required to keep a record of the receipt for at least 2 years and it would be prudent to keep official donation receipts for up to 7 years

When to Issue Official Donation receipts?

Official donation receipts can be made for:

voluntary transfer of property (e.g. cash, stocks, equipment)

Split Receipting

If the donor receives an "advantage", split receipting should be used and the advantage subtracted from the eligible amount.*

- After subtracting the fair market value of the advantage it should meet the intention to make a gift threshold of more than 80% of the fair market value of the gift itself.
- *If the advantage is of nominal value, less than 10% of the FMV of the gift, the advantage does not have to be subtracted.

For non-cash gifts, fair market value must be determined. If it cannot be determined, a donation receipt cannot be issued.


What are some common issues with tax receipting?

- Missing details and mistakes
- Difficult to keep track of
- Unable to collaborate
- Cost prohibitive
- Delays in sending receipts and thank you messages
- Issuing annual aggregated receipts is difficult
- Storage issues & Difficult to search



Missing Details & Mistakes

- Are you recording unique serial numbers and details such as name, address and eligible gift amounts?
- Do your fields have data validation text entry vs. number entry, typos
 - Province
 - Number fields
 - Date fields
- After data is entered, is the information locked?







Keeping Track

Are you able to keep track if that official donation receipt has been sent out or not?

There should be a data field that confirms whether or not it was sent and a date that it was sent.



Collaboration Issues

Are your spreadsheets static documents that are on your local network?

You may end up with multiple versions of the same records and have to handle reconciling differences at a later date.

A step up from static excel documents is using an organizational Google or Office 365 account. Both <u>Google</u> and <u>Microsoft</u> offer discounts or free licenses for charities which allows collaboration in the Cloud.




Cost Prohibitive

Are you sending your donation receipts by mail?

There is a very real cost to print, purchase envelopes and pay for postage. This becomes increasingly costly as your charity grows and scales.

While email is more cost-effective, coordinating tax receipt delivery to supporters can be difficult without a system or marketing tool.



Delays in Sending Receipts & Thank You Messages

Are you sending your receipts and thank you messages at the right cadence?

It is best practice to send thank you messages as soon as possible but tax receipts can be sent when donors require them around February/March in the following year.




Issuing Annual Receipts

Are you issuing annual/aggregate receipts according to donor preference?

Sometimes donors give multiple times in a year but want just one aggregated receipt at the end of the year for their taxes.

This can be difficult, if not impossible when done manually.



Storage Issues & Difficult To Search

Are you storing your receipts securely?

Receipts need to be stored for at least 2 years for potential CRA auditing. However, it is prudent to keep them for up to 7 years.

Physical copies take up space, can be easily damaged and require extra work in scanning receipts.


While storing your receipts is one thing, being able to track down the receipt you need when one needs to be reissued another.
